

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE?

All apprenticeships are based on National Certificate and Diploma qualifications which are made up of a selection of unit standards registered with the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA) on the New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF).

These qualifications have been developed by the NZ Marine ITO in direct consultation with employers and other key stakeholders, ensuring that the qualifications offered are industry relevant and accepted. Regular reviews take place to ensure the qualifications are up to date with technological changes and industry expectations / requirements.

While the qualifications do not state a fixed time duration, it is expected that apprentices should be achieving on average 70 credits per annum. As an example, it may take a composite boatbuilder undergoing a 338 credit qualification up to 5 years to complete, however, some will complete earlier depending on their abilities and the opportunities they have in their workplaces.
